**Islamabad, 07 December 2020:** President Dr Arif Alvi has said that Pakistan highly values its ties with Belarus and wants to further enhance bilateral relations with Belarus in all fields of mutual interest, including trade and investment, science and technology, culture and defense. He stated this while talking to the outgoing Ambassador of the Republic of Belarus, Mr Andrei Ermolovich, who paid a farewell call on him, at Aiwan-e-Sadr, today.
